

Team Ocean Kayak sets a new State Fishing Record

Team Ocean Kayak 's Vincent Rinando set the Galveston Bay speckled trout catch and release body of water state record for Texas on January 14, 2011. Vincent and teammates Sam Rinando and Captain Filip Spencer were out fishing for trout to display at the Houston Boat show when the fish was caught.

Teammate Rick Spillman was first to hold this state record last year while we were out winter trophy trout fishing. A few short weeks later teammate Clint Barghi too this record from Rick at almost the same location.

Clint held onto the record at 28 inches throughout the remainder of the winter in 2010 until teammate Vincent Rinando broke the record with a nice 29 inch trout. Moments later Vincent landed another trophy trout at 28 inches.

This year has been a great year for trophy trout, it's likely that Vincent will pass this record onto another teammate before the year is over. If not, there is always next year.
