### Team Ocean Kayak Introduction to Coastal Kayaking Class Galveston, Texas

On May 6, 2007 Team Ocean Kayak held an introduction to coastal kayaking class at the sailing club in Galveston. The class was taught by Jeff Herman, Vincent Rinando and three members of Artist Boats. Team Ocean Kayak puts on this event as a fund raiser for Artist Boat, a non-profit organization that takes over two thousand kids into the coastal marsh in kayaks to introduce them to coastal stewardship, arts and science. The instructors donate their time for this event and all proceeds go towards purchasing an Ocean Kayak to add to their fleet of kayaks for the kids. This allows Team Ocean Kayak to keep the cost of this instruction down to 25.00 per person. We always have a great turnout for this event and have to close the class at twenty students. There is already a line forming for the next class.

Here is some of the feedback we've received about this class.

The "Artist Boat" instructors were great, and the benefit to their educational programs is well worth assisting by attending one of these classes. I've been lucky enough so far to not have to find that out "the hard way". I was stoked that it was as simple as it was, and I have a lot more confidence in it as a result. Learning how to help another yakker get back in their boat was something I hope to not ever have to use, but I think it will be a very useful piece of knowledge if I ever need it. I'm really happy that I took the class. The Eskimo roll demo by Kris was something I'd been wanting to see in person for a million years. Very cool! On a scale of 1 to 10, I'd give it a 10 for being something worth giving up a day of fishing for. I learned a lot, met some really nice folks, and had a blast. You might be able to get back in your boat unassisted, but what if the other people in your party can't? Do you know how to properly help someone else flip their boat and get back in? I didn't, but I do now

That was pretty much the greatest deal of all time; I really didn't know just how much of a neophyte at this I was. I'm also a heck of a lot more confident at getting back in the yak than I ever was before. Anybody that ever gets a chance to do this ought to jump on it QUICK.



Team Ocean Kayak's Vincent Rinando set a new body of water record on the fly rod for speckled trout for the Galveston bay complex. This is a record that Vincent has been chasing, when he broke the record unknowingly last year, but failed to have his catch certified. Vincent's trout was 24 3/4" long and weighed 5.2lbs. Texas Parks and Wildlife have been keeping fishing records for Galveston Island since the early 1900s. Team Ocean Kayak currently holds 24 Texas State Fishing Records.
